

In Search of 'Maud'



On Thursday August 23, 2007, the Gainesville Sun featured the January 2007 theft of the 5-foot marble sculpture 'Maud' from Evergreen Cemetery. This memorial marked the grave of Maud Truby, a young woman interred in Evergreen Cemetery in 1904.

The Evergreen Cemetery Association of Gainesville, Inc. has offered a \$1,000 reward for the safe return of 'Maud'.

The feelings of loss of this exquisite sculpture and cemetery landmark are best expressed by the inscription on its remaining pedestal which reads, **"Dearest child thou hast left us and thy loss we deeply feel"**.
