

What is the Downtown Festival & Art Show?

- © The streets of historic downtown Gainesville will be transformed into a celebration of art and creativity at North Central Florida's premier fall festival of the arts. It is one of the largest and most distinguished fine arts shows in the country. The festival has consistently ranked in the top 200 shows in the nation and this year it was ranked No. 27 among the best 200 fine art shows in the country by Sunshine Artist magazine and Greg Lawler's Art Fair SourceBook included the show in its list of the nation's top 100 fine art festival.
- © This outdoor festival brings more than 100,000 visitors to stroll through the streets to purchase one-of-a-kind artwork from the nation's top artists.
- © Visitors can marvel at original oils and acrylics, vibrant watercolors, unique sculptures, dazzling jewelry, decorative ceramics and vivid photography. Volunteers and guests can also take time to start their holiday shopping.
- © Entertainment on three stages features continuous, live musical performances by local bands, solo artists and dance companies, and includes a free Downtown Blues Concert Friday evening.
- © Dozens of food vendors provide a diverse array of ethnic foods, and a community information area is available for local nonprofit organizations.
- © Fun for the entire family at the "Imagination Station," a creative, hands-on art activities and interactive area.
- © FREE! The show is open to the public from 10 a.m. until 5 p.m. all weekend.
